## YOU MUST BE ON TIME FOR YOUR CLASS IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE

Class 46 Pre-Novice Open to any adult terrier. Ten maximum in each group; all commands on-leash. To be judged individually: heel, heel figure 8 , stand for exam, recall. Honor sit or down.
Class 47 Novice Open to any adult terrier. To be judged individually; heel on-leash, off-lead figure 8, stand for exam, recall off-leash. Honor sit or down.
Class 48 Open Open to any adult terrier. To be judged individually; heel free, off-lead figure 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high-jump and broad jump.
Class 49 Obedience High Point \& High Point Reserve (Non-Sanctioned \& no entry fee) To be awarded to the highest combination of scores in classes 47 and 48. Most advanced class breaking tie.

## DIVISION C: RALLY OBEDIENCE DIVISION (www.rallydogs.com)

Class 50 Companion Rally. Open to any adult terrier. Performed on-lead. May be same course as Rally I. This class is for the companion terrier who has little or no formal Obedience training. A true beginner class. May not cross-enter Rally I or Rally II.
Class 51 Rally I. Open to any adult terrier. Performed on-lead. Numbered course of 1-15 signs. Performed on loose lead at a normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. May cross-enter into Rally II.
Class 52 Rally II. Open to any adult terrier. Performed off-lead. Numbered course of 15-18 signs. Course the same as Rally I with different or added exercises of more difficulty. May cross-enter into Rally I.
Class 53 Rally-O High Point \& High Point Reserve (Non-Sanctioned \& no entry fee) To be awarded to the highest combination of scores from Rally I \& II-Classes 51 \& 52. Most advanced class breaking the tie.

## DIVISION D: YOUTH (Youth Tee-Shirts Sponsored by John Butler \& Crystal Jones)

Class 54 Child Handler - Immediately following Working Terrier Grand Entry. Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.
Class 55 Youth Handler - Immediately following Child Handler Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult JRT. Judged on the Youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the JRT. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.
Class 56 Working Judge's Choice - Open to any youth aged 10 through 16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany Youth into class.
Class 57 Youth Handler Agility (On-Lead) - Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult JRT. To be run over the Novice Agility course. Time not to be considered. Judged on the youth's ability to handle the terrier and knowledge of Agility.
Class 58 Child Go-To-Ground - Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/ her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10 -foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before It can compete in Child Go-To-Ground. (Non-Sanctioned)
Class 59 Youth Go-To-Ground - Immediately after Obedience - Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10 ft . novice liner. Time NOT to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before it can compete in Youth GTG.
Class 60 Child Handler High Score \& Reserve - Awarded to the highest scoring Child Handler and runner-up in classes 54 \& 58 . The points are awarded as follows: $1^{\text {st }}=8$ points; $2^{\text {nd }}=6$ points; $3^{\text {rd }}=5$ points; $4^{\text {th }}=4$ points; $5^{\text {th }}$ place $=3$ points, $6^{\text {th }}$ place $=2$ points, and participation $=1$ point. (Non-Sanctioned)
Class 61 Youth Handler High Score \& Reserve - Awarded to the highest scoring Youth and runner-up in classes 55, 56 \& 59. The points are awarded as follows: 1 st $=8$ points; 2 nd $=6$ points; 3 rd $=5$ points; 4 th $=4$ points; 5 th place $=3$ points, 6 th place $=2$ points, and participation $=1$ point.

Child Exhibitors must compete in a both Child Handler \& Child GTG in order to qualify for the Child Handler High Score \& Reserve. Youth Exhibitors must compete in Youth Handler, Working Judge's Choice and Youth GTG in order to qualify for the Youth High Score \& Reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a Handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring; Judge to be decided by the Trial Administrator.

Class 85 Three Generations. Open to a minimum of 3 successive generations of breeding; second and successive generations must be bred by Exhibitor. Judged on conformation and improvement.
Class 86 Family Working Class. Open to Working Stud Dogs and Working Brood Bitches with at least two, but no more than three adult working off spring at side. All terriers must have earned and received one or more JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificates.

Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)
Class 117 NOVICE PUPPY Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 mos. which have not scored $100 \%$ in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of $100 \%$ at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial. (1 minute to reach quarry, may leave earth \& reenter several times, work quarry for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.) If a terrier has passed the Novice Puppy class, the terrier may not enter ANY novice puppy class ever again.
Class 118 OPEN PUPPY Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 mos. which have scored $100 \%$ in a Novice GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved $100 \%$ in this class. Puppies earning a score of $100 \%$ at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. ( 30 seconds to reach quarry, may leave the earth once \& re-enter; work quarry for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)
Class 119 PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP GTG Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 mos. which have earned $100 \%$ in an Open Puppy GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a $100 \%$ open score sheet must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Puppy GTG Champion \& Reserve. ( 30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once \& re-enter, work quarry for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving the quarry, may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.) (Perpetual Trophy awarded on Saturday)
Class 120 NOVICE ADULT Open to JRT's 1 yr. or older which have not scored $100 \%$ in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earing a score of $100 \%$ at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open Adult class at this trial. (1 minute to reach quarry, may leave earth \& reenter several times, work quarry for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)
If a terrier has passed the Novice Puppy class or Novice Adult class, the terrier may not enter ANY Novice class ever again. Terriers must be recorded or registered to participate in Certificate classes.

Class 121 OPEN ADULT Open to JRT's, one year or older, which have scored 100\% in a Novice GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. MAY NOT enter the Championship Certificate Class at this trial. ( 30 seconds to reach quarry, may leave earth once and re-enter, work quarry for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another).

## CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES

Class 122 10" up to $12.5^{"}$ CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any adult JRT 1 yr. \& over which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& $2^{\text {nd }}$ place winners will be GTG Champion \& Reserve.
Class 123 Over 12.5" up to 15 " CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 1 yr. \& over which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Crossentering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Adult Under GTG Champion \& Reserve. (Perpetual Trophy awarded on Saturday)

Class 124 10" up to 12.5 " VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 6 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes.1st \& 2nd place winners will be Veteran Under GTG Champion \& Reserve.
Class 125 Over 12.5" up to 15 " VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 6 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Veteran Over GTG Champion \& Reserve.

Class 126 10" up to $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 9 yrs. or older which holds a JRTC Trial Certificate. Crossentering is not permitted between certificate Classes. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Senior Under GTG Champion \& Reserve.
Class 127 Over 12.5" up to 15" SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG. Open to any JRT 9 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Senior Over GTG Champion \& Reserve.

## DIVISION G: SUPER EARTH (CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES) Please note that your terrier must reach the quarry within the allotted time designated by the length of the tunnels

Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached and then must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Class 132 Over $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ up to $15^{\prime \prime}$ Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.
Class 1336 UP TO 12 MONTH PUPPY SUPER EARTH CHAMPIONSHIP. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 mos. which have earned 100\% in an Open Puppy Open class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a $100 \%$ open score sheet must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be 6 up to 12 month Puppy Super Earth Champion \& Reserve.
Class 134 10" up to 12.5 " ADULT CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any adult JRT 1 yr. \& older, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Adult Under Super Earth Champion \& Reserve.
Class 135 Over 12.5 " up to 15 " ADULT CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any adult JRT 1 yr. \& older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Adult Over Super Earth Champion \& Reserve.

Class 136 10" up to $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 6 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Veteran Under Super Earth Champion \& Reserve.
Class 137 Over 12.5" up to 15" VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 6 years or older, which holds a JRTCA Su per Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Veteran Over Super Earth Champion \& Reserve.

Class 138 10" up to 12.5 " SENIOR CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 9 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Senior Under Super Earth Champion \& Reserve.
Class 139 Over 12.5" up to 15 " SENIOR CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 9 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st \& 2nd place winners will be Senior Over Super Earth Champion \& Reserve. must end in a "gamble." Qualifying score will be 200. Gamble set to $8-10$ feet. No cross entering into Class 142.
Class 141 AGIIITY II CERTIFICATE: Off-Lead. Time $2.25+10 \%$. More difficult course to include all of the Agility I equipment plus two more hurdles, weave poles, and see-saw. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg towards JRTCA Agility II Certificate. No cross entering into Class 142.

Class 142 AGILITY I CERTIFICATE: Off-Lead. Time $1.75 \%$ + 10\%. Handlers may remain in this class. Open to any adult terrier. All three legs of Agility I Certificate are earned with three qualifying scores of 190 or above. Three qualifying scores may move entrant of this class onto Agility II, III and Jumpers/Games. This course is used for Youth Agility On-Lead. No see-saw or tire jump in this class. No cross entering into Classes 140 \& 141.
Class 143 Jumpers/Game - Off-lead. Consists of $12-17$ jumps and/or tunnels with at least one lead change. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting ${ }^{\text {st }}$ regardless of number of faults. Five faults for running course on-lead; five faults for knocked bar, and off-course. 15 faults for missed obstacle. Qualifying score of 200 earns one leg towards a JRTCA Jumpers/Game Certificate.
Class 144 AGILITY HIGH SCORE CHAMPION \& RESERVE To be awarded to the high score terrier and runner-up combining scores of Agility II, Agility III and qualifying no fault score in Jumpers/Game (Classes 140, 141, 143). Ties are broken by fastest time. No entry fee.

## Section 2 (Non-Sanctioned, On-Lead Classes / ABSOLUTELY NO FLEXI-LEADS)

Class 145 NOVICE ON-LEAD - Time YPS 150. Open to any adult terriers which have not scored above 190 pts. This class is for the true beginner terrier with the intent of a pleasant experience on the basic agility equipment. Handlers who drag their terriers around will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various hurdles. (Although this class is for the beginner, terrier needs to have prior exposure to Agility equipment.) (Non-Sanctioned)
Class 146 ADVANCED ON-LEAD - Open to any adult terriers that have previously achieved a score of 190 or better in Novice On-Lead. Course the same as Novice On-Lead with the addition of the see-saw. (Non-Sanctioned)

## NOTE: Terriers entered in Novice \& Advanced On-Lead classes may not cross enter Off-Lead Classes.

Class 147
JUMPERS ON-LEAD - Consists of 12-17 jumps and/or tunnels. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1st, regardless of number of faults. Five faults for knocked bar, and off-course. 15 faults for missed obstacle. (Non-Sanctioned)
Class 148 AGILITY ADVANCED ON-LEAD HIGH SCORE CHAMPION \& RESERVE (Non-Sanctioned, no entry fee). To be awarded to the high-score terrier and runner-up combining scores of Classes 146 \& 147. Ties are broken by fastest time.

## DIVISION I: TRAILING \& LOCATING

Class 149 Puppies. 6 up to 12 months. The terrier is judged on his ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on quarry.
Class 150 Adults. 1 year and older. The terrier is judged on his ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on quarry.
Class 151 Brace. Two adult terriers working as a team. Judged on their ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on quarry.
